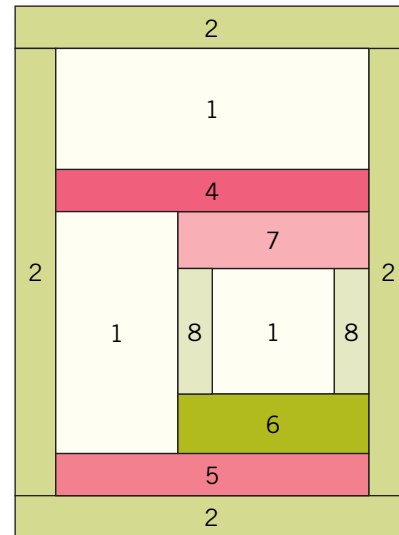

- GO! Heart-2", 3", 4" (55029)
- GO! Round Flower (55007)

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

-  Fabric 1—¾ yard
-  Fabric 2—⅓ yard for border
-  Fabric 3—⅓ yard for binding
-  Fabric 4—⅓ yard or fat quarter
-  Fabric 5—⅓ yard or fat quarter
-  Fabric 6—⅓ yard or fat quarter
-  Fabric 7—⅓ yard or fat quarter
-  Fabric 8—⅓ yard or fat quarter
- Appliqué fabrics—fat quarters or scraps
- Fusible web—½ yard
- Backing—¾ yard
- Batting—25" x 33"

### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*Tip: Use GO! Strip Cutters to cut the right size strips, then sub cut to create rectangle sizes.*

#### Fabric 1:

- Cut 1—6½" strip across the width of fabric (WOF)  
Sub cut into 1—6½" x 15" rectangle; 1—6½" x 12½" rectangle; and 1—6½" x 6½" square

#### Fabric 2:

- Cut 3—2½" strips across the WOF  
Sub cut into 2—2½" x 22½" rectangles;  
and 2—2½" x 19" rectangles

### CUTTING DIRECTIONS *cont.*

#### Fabric 3:

- Cut 3—2½" strips across the WOF

#### Fabric 4:

- Cut 1—2½" x 15" rectangle

#### Fabric 5:

- Cut 1—2½" x 15" rectangle

#### Fabric 6:

- Cut 1—3½" x 9" rectangle

#### Fabric 7:

- Cut 1—3½" x 9" rectangle

#### Fabric 8:

- Cut 2—1¾" x 6½" rectangles

#### Appliqué Fabrics:

*Apply fusible web to wrong side of selected fabrics before cutting.*

- Cut 1—4" heart
- Cut 3—3" hearts
- Cut 3—2" hearts
- Cut 1—butterfly
- Cut 1—dragonfly (trim off wings)
- Cut 1—round flower
- Cut 1—1" circle
- Cut 1—stem
- Cut 2—leaves

### SEWING DIRECTIONS

*Tip: Press seams toward each added piece.*

1. Lay out fabrics according to quilt diagram.
2. Lay out appliqué shapes on appropriate squares and rectangles using photo as a guide. Fuse in place following manufacturer's instructions. Machine appliqué with narrow zigzag stitch.
3. Pin and sew one Fabric #8, 1¾" x 6½" rectangle to each side of butterfly appliqué Fabric #1, 6½" square. Press seams toward rectangles.
4. Pin and sew Fabric #6, 3½" x 9" rectangle to the bottom of combined unit. Press seams toward added rectangle.
5. Pin and sew Fabric #7, 3½" x 9" rectangle to the top of combined unit. Press seams toward added rectangle.
6. Pin and sew Fabric #1, 6½" x 12½" appliqué rectangle to the side of combined unit. Press seams toward added rectangle.

7. Pin and sew Fabric #5, 2½" x 15" rectangle to the bottom of combined unit. Press seams toward added rectangle.
8. Pin and sew Fabric #4, 2½" x 15" rectangle to the top of combined unit. Press seams toward added rectangle.
9. Pin and sew Fabric #1, 6½" x 15" appliqué rectangle to the top of combined unit. Press seams toward added rectangle.
10. Add one Fabric #2, 2½" x 22½" rectangle to each side of quilt center. Press seams toward border.
11. Add one Fabric #2, 2½" x 19" rectangle to top and bottom of quilt center.

### QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
