Fabric provided by Moda Fabrics.

- GO! Awareness Ribbon (55355)
- GO! Half Rectangle Triangle-3" x 6" Finished Rectangle (55411)
- GO! Square-3-1/2" (3" Finished) (55006)
- GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (55000)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1 (White)—3 yards
- Fabric 2 (Pink)—1 3/4 yards
- Binding—3/4 yard
- Fusible web product—3/4 yard
- Batting—50" x 50"
- Backing—3 yards

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

NOTE: Apply fusible web to the wrong side of selected fabrics for appliqué following the manufacturer's instructions.

FABRIC 1:

- Cut 8—6-1/2" squares
- Cut 25—3-1/2" squares
- Cut 40—3" x 6" finished half rectangles
- Cut 6—2-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips
- Cut 8—Awareness Ribbons

Fabric 2:

- Cut 8—6-1/2" squares
- Cut 40—3" x 6" finished half rectangles
- Cut 8—Awareness Ribbons

Binding

- Cut 6—2-1/2" x WOF strips

SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Layer one Fabric #1 3" x 6" finished half rectangle with one Fabric #2 3" x 6" half rectangle.
2. Pin and sew together. Press towards Fabric #2. Unit should measure 3-1/2" x 6-1/2".
3. Make a total of 40, 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" half rectangle blocks.
4. Iron fusible web onto the backside of your appliqué fabrics.
5. Cut out eight Fabric #1 Awareness Ribbons and eight Fabric #2 Awareness Ribbons.
6. Center and fuse one Fabric #2 Awareness Ribbon diagonally on one Fabric #1 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" square.
7. Make a total of eight Fabric #1 Blocks.

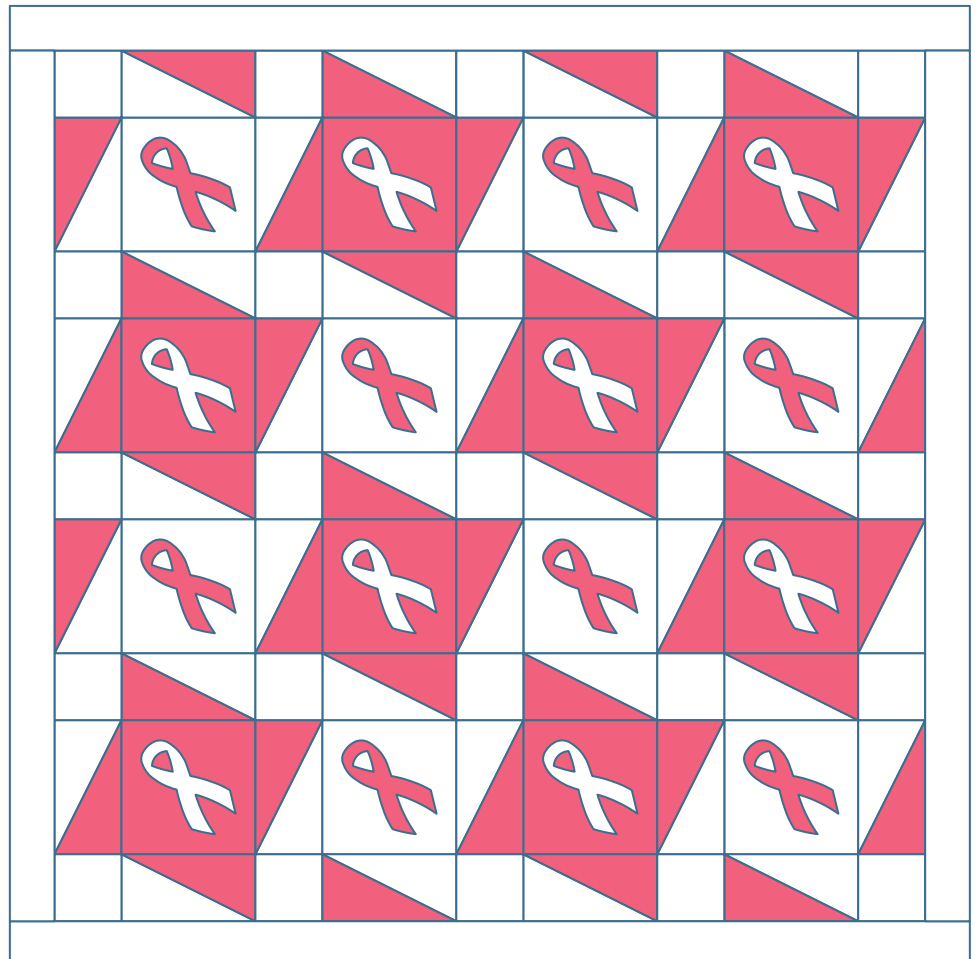

8. Center and fuse one Fabric #1 Awareness Ribbon diagonally on one Fabric #2, 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" square.
9. Make a total of eight Fabric #2 Blocks.
10. Using a decorative stitch on your machine, stitch around the edges of the appliqué shapes to secure them to the quilt top.
11. Lay out (40) Half Rectangle Units, (25) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares, (8) Appliqué Block #1 Units, and (8) Appliqué Block #2 Units as shown in the diagram.
12. Sew blocks together into rows pressing seams in opposite directions.
13. Sew rows together pressing seams in the same direction.
14. Sew together the six Fabric #1, 2-1/2" x WOF strips along the short side.
15. Measure the length of the quilt in the center. Cut two borders to this length.
16. Pin and sew the border onto the left and right side of the quilt. Pressing towards the borders.
17. Measure the width of the quilt in the center. Cut two borders to this length.
18. Pin and sew the border onto the top and bottom of the quilt.

QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was custom machine quilted.
4. Add binding, mitering the corners.
